Course Description

The Scottish Rite Philosophy Course focuses on developing a Brother's understanding of the Scottish Rite's lessons and philosophy as explained by the ritual work of the Scottish Rite, Southern Jurisdiction through an explanation of Albert Pike's 1872 seminal work *Morals and Dogma*. Brothers will utilize Albert Pike's *Morals & Dogma*: Annotated Edition for course study in particular. Lessons will take a step by step look at every degree from Entered Apprentice to Master of the Royal Secret.

The Valley of Alexandria's Study Group will use a virtual format as we work together through the 10 courses. Working online enables participants to interact with the instructor and group without leaving home. Other than the cost to purchase the course and book, the study group is offered free of charge.
